The SUPEERA Website (www.supeera.eu) was launched at the end of April 2019 (M4), serving as a key part of the Digital Communication tools of the project. The website is integrated in the EERA web portal, which gathers, besides the EERA central website, websites of its Joint Programmes and EU-funded projects that are of strategic relevance to EERA. A web portal approach allows for cross-sharing and interlinked content via a centralised administration. Thanks to this functionality, it will be very easy for the EERA Joint Programmes and other EERA aisbl projects that are part of the system to display SUPEERA content also on their websites, increasing the dissemination of information in relevant communities. It will also allow to keep results and materials available on the SUPEERA public website after the project completion.

The homepage includes a Welcome message and the key visual of the project, together with its full name and a top menu for the different sections of the website: a section to present the project ("About Us"), a section to share the main events, a collection of the available news and resources, a compendium of the project's deliverables and a section to give users the possibility to get in contact with the team. 













2.1 Menu Item - About us:

- <u>Partners</u>: offers a visual rendering of the partners involved in SUPEERA and the type of organisation they are.






 <u>Contacts</u>: provides an overview of the main contacts for the project, their roles and their email addresses.

- Press releases: materials for the press developed by the SUPEERA team


2.4 Menu Item - Deliverables:
